<u>Order</u>

Government of India, Ministry of Home affairs vide its order No.40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 29/04/2020 has allowed inter-state movement of stranded labourers, pilgrims, tourists and other stranded persons. Many residents of Chhattisgarh are stuck in other states and vice-versa. Stranded people intend to return to their home states. Chhattisgarh is also a transit state for stranded persons of many states going to their destinations in another state. Hence an urgent need has been felt to create a mechanism at the state level to ensure prompt response, for coordination with other states and between districts, and to facilitate smooth inter-state movement of people. Therefore a coordination cell is hereby established by the government at the state level which shall comprise of the following nodal officers to coordinate with other nodal officers of States/UTs mentioned against their names:

District administration, Local bodies, officials of Labour department, Industries department, Mining department, Home department, Transport department, Panchayat and Rural development department, Urban welfare department are hereby directed to provide necessary support.
- 3. State Control Room of Labour department will collect data about all labour related movement in and out of State as per extant instructions.
